CLINICAL SERVICE:

Introduced an opioid free pathway for all robotic surgery at the Rush University Medical Center in August 2013 through March 2018. Minimal opioid prescriptions for patients undergoing robotic urological surgery. Shortest length of stay for all robotic and laparoscopic surgery patients when compared to peers.

Performed the first robotic assisted laparoscopic repair of a rectovesical fistula in the state of Illinois at Rush University Medical Center in September 2016. This was a complex multidisciplinary approach involving the colorectal surgery team and urology, providing a minimally invasive approach to a challenging clinical problem.

Performed the first robotic assisted laparoscopic radical cystectomy and totally intracorporeal ileal neobladder in the state of Illinois at Rush University Medical Center in August 2014. Continued the program for 4 years at Rush University Medical Center and this was the only program performing intracorporeal urinary diversion in the state of Illinois.

Introduced an opioid free pathway for all robotic surgery at the Miami Veterans Affairs Medical Center in August 2018. This pathway has reduced the use of post-operative opioids following major robotic urological procedures from 100 % to 6 % during hospital admission and from 100 % to 0 % at discharge. Since that time, no opioid prescriptions have been written at discharge for patients undergoing robotic surgery.
