

Ginette A. Okoye, M.D. is associate dean for Clinical Affairs and professor and chair of dermatology at Howard University College of Medicine. A nationally recognized dermatologist, educator and academic leader, her clinical and research interests focus on hidradenitis suppurativa and advancing health equity in dermatologic care. She has authored more than 100 publications and is editor of *The Fundamentals of Ethnic Hair: The Dermatologist's Perspective*.

Okoye earned her bachelor's degree from Barry University and her medical degree from Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons. She completed her dermatology residency at Yale University.
